Parents and carers will work towards the School's Christian aims by:

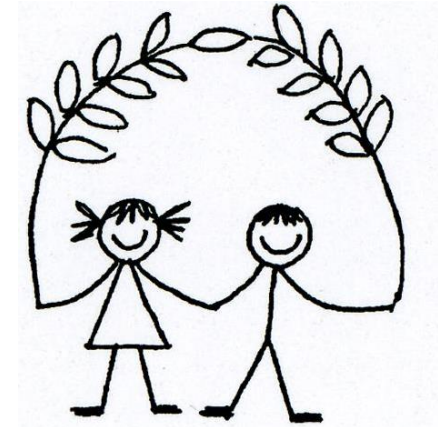
- ✓ Ensure that children are appropriately dressed for the weather, with no jewellery except simple ear studs and a watch.
