Move of Fencing

It has been strongly suggested by the LA that the toilets need to be more easily accessible for our youngest children when they are outside. We have looked into a number of options to allow for this but have so far been unable to make this happen - until now! We are moving the internal fence and gate (by the children's entrance) to allow access through the children's entrance to the toilets and will also give us a larger outside area for the EYFS children at the side of the building. This will allow us to unlock the children's entrance to the cloakroom/toilets, aiding the children's access to the toilets, when school is in session whilst keeping the children safe by locking the gate. Each morning and afternoon, as well as at playtime and lunchtime, the gates will be opened to allow all the children to enter/leave the main building by the normal route.
