All about Crucial Crew

On Thursday 7th June the Y6 went on an education trip to Crucial Crew. Crucial Crew is a trip where you get to learn about and view scenarios that could happen in the future, for example, how to ring 999, what to do in a fire, who to fine if there is an emergency on the beach, how to keep safe near pylons and lots more. First of all we congregated in the hall and got put into groups then we went to our first activity which taught us what to do if you have a gas leak. It was very interesting and we learnt lots.

There were lots more talks like how to keep safe on the internet, what to do if you see someone shop lifting, what to do in a fire, we listened to all the talks and took all the information in. One thing that I learnt was if you are somewhere and you smell smoke use the back of your hand and put it on the door handle if it is hot you know there is a fire on the other side, and the reason you should use the back of your hand is so you pull away if it's hot but if you used the other side of your hand you will grab the door handle as a natural reaction. (Metal is a conductor of heat)

We came away from Crucial Crew knowing a lot more than we did already.

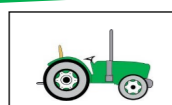
