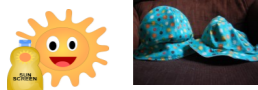
We will confirm your child's place on the morning of Tuesday 8th June for the 7 weeks. If take up of the club is good, we hope to run this next year too.

Please can we remind parents when you are all in the playground to keep 2 meters apart and wear your face mask, when dropping off your children and collect them at the start and end of the school day.

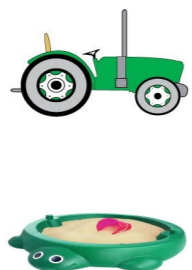
