child born between 1 September 2015 and 31st Au-
gust 2016 they will be eligible to start primary
school in September 2020. You need to apply for a
place at your selected school even if they are at-
tending a nursery that is attached to the primary
school. This can only be done online. Applications
close on 15th January 2020.
