I hope that you all have a lovely half term with your families and we will see you all again when we return on Monday 2nd November.

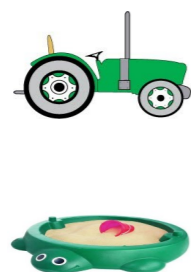
